Jack Barden presented details about a quintet organized by Hilary Janacek, the flutist who used our sanctuary for a recent flute recital. Various committees will be involved in planning a concert by the quintet once a date is set.

Terry McKetta reported that we will not provide a Teacher Appreciation Luncheon for Bee Cave Elementary teachers this year.

Mission - The Committee did not meet. Jack reported that one of the Hudson Bend RV parks, New World, has been sold but current resident can remain for at least two years. In the Armadillo RV park, Esme, our liaison, has moved and her employment with PCLT will end at the

end of May. For a number of reasons, this is a good time to cease food distribution in Hudson Bend. Our efforts could be better used in other ways. The committee will discuss this their June meeting.

Old Business

Our Summer Intern, Rabert Sheppard, will be introduced to the congregation on June 5, Pentecost Sunday. We will pay him \$250/week.


New Business


Mission Presbytery meets June 10-11 in San Antonio. Delegates will be Lynn Fisher and Jack Barden.
